Roach Preparation Instructions

Preparation Steps:

Clean the home prior to the Technicians visit and maintain the home as neatly as possible for long-term results. This helps to eliminate competing food sources for the roaches. Additionally, when the home is clean, the roaches will be more easily attracted to the bait and not to food sources.

1. Cover and store any open food. Remove all foods, small appliances, and other small items completely from countertops, stove top.
2. Remove all items from cabinets as follows:
Kitchen – Pantry Cabinets, Silverware Drawers & Under the Sink Area
Bathroom – Vanity cabinets & Under the Sink Areas
3. Store and/or cover baby toys, supplies and crib mattress
4. Prior to the treatment you must mop/scrub kitchen, bathroom and other hard floors and woodwork with detergent. Thoroughly vacuum carpeted floors.
5. Vacuum up any visible roaches and eggs just before the service visit, using the crevice attachment to get into cracks. After vacuuming, take the vacuum cleaner outside, remove the vacuum bag, seal it, and discard in trash. Take a damp cloth and wipe down the entire vacuum cleaner. Continue to vacuum or otherwise kill any roaches that are seen.

6. Always keep garbage in closed containers and take out the garbage the night before the treatment and every night after to prevent infestation.
7. Remove items from the top of the refrigerator, stove, and any other such movable appliances. Prior to treatment, move these appliances away from the wall, and clean behind and beneath them. If the stove has a removable bottom drawer that opens to the floor, it is not necessary to move the entire stove.
8. Be sure that the Technician has free and full access to anywhere that cockroaches have been seen.
9. Discard all excess paper products, and any other unused piles or trash, as these are harborage areas for roaches and other pests.
10. Homeowners should repair any water leaks immediately upon detection; apartment residents should report the leak to maintenance immediately upon detection.
11. If anyone in the home has special allergy problems, is pregnant, or is under the age of one, the technician should be informed prior to the service and precautions taken. All people and pets should stay out of the area being serviced for the length of time as specified by the technician. They are as follows:
 - Adults: 4-6 Hours
 - Children & Elderly: 6-8 Hours
 - Infants: 8-10 Hours
12. After service, keep sanitation to as high a level as possible to allow all products to work as swiftly as possible. Do not touch cockroach gel or allow children or pets to get near it also. You must wait at least 14 days before washing or wiping down any areas that have been treated in order to allow the treatment to be successful. You may notice an increase of roach activity. If this occurs, please do not be concerned as this is the result of the treatment driving the roaches out of their nesting areas.
